
How does it work?

Why should I do it?



Compost helps strengthen soils ability to retain water. This causes plants to not need to be watered as frequently.



Composting helps divert materials from going to the landfills, minimizing the amount of green house gas emissions released.



Compost supplies soil with nutrients like phosphorous and nitrogen, reducing the need for fertilizer.
