Electric Vehicle Charging Station Permit Checklist

A permit is required to install an Electric Vehicle (EV) Charging Station. Please submit all materials in person or electronically to: building@broadview-il.gov

WHAT YOU NEED TO APPLY:

- 1. Building Permit Application
- 2. Existing plat of survey that has been marked up to show the entire site plan
- 3. Charging station specifications (i.e., manufacturer's brochure)
- 4. Electrical load calculations
- 5. Copy of the Electrician's license
- 6. Illinois Commerce Commission Registration number

PERMIT FEES:

Once the permit has been reviewed and approved, permit fees must be paid before work begins.

The Fees for an EV charging station are as follows:

Residential EV charging station permit fees have a flat rate of \$75

Commercial, Industrial, and Multi-Unit Residential EV charging station permit fees are \$240, plus the Development Services fee (\$6.70 per \$1,000 of the cost of construction, minimum \$50.00). The minimum EV charging station permit fee is \$290.00.

REQUIRED INSPECTIONS:

- •Two inspections are required: a rough and a final inspection.
- •A final inspection is scheduled once everything is completed.
- •Inspections must be scheduled with the Building Department.
- Inspections are not accepted over the phone or through email.

COMED NOTIFICATION

The Village recommends that the vehicle owner register the EV with ComEd.
