The Village of Broadview continues to demonstrate sound financial management and a clear vision for the future. As of the end of FY22, the Village's net position increased by \$4.0 million, reflecting a 37.2% growth. Additionally, the General Fund balance stood at \$5.0 million, positioning Broadview for sustained fiscal success.

This past Tuesday, Trustee Jarry Shelby, Chairwoman of the Finance Committee, hosted a finance committee meeting to discuss the Village's financial health and initiatives. The meeting highlighted the Village's strong commitment to fiscal responsibility, with exciting projections indicating that the current surplus is set to double in the coming years, a testament to careful and strategic management.

The Village's Key Priorities:

- 1. Ensuring Fiscal Responsibility Across Departments: Budgets are carefully monitored to ensure all spending aligns with the Village's goals and community priorities.
- 2. Spending Within Our Means: The Village avoids unnecessary expenses while prioritizing investments in programs and services that directly benefit residents.
- 3. Serving with Excellence: Efforts are focused on continually enhancing services to meet the needs of Broadview residents efficiently and with the highest quality.

The Village is also making strides toward long-term growth and development with the creation of a 20-Year Comprehensive Plan. This initiative will serve as a roadmap for Broadview's future, focusing on sustainable progress, community engagement, and shared prosperity. Residents are encouraged to stay engaged as the draft plan will be available for review in late January or early February.
