On **June 19, 1865,** Union Major General Gordon Granger issued this military order in Galveston, Texas, freeing slaves.

GENERAL ORDERS, NO. 3

"THE PEOPLE OF TEXAS ARE INFORMED THAT,
IN ACCORDANCE WITH A PROCLAMINATION FROM THE
EXECUTIVE OF THE UNITED STATES,

ALL SLAVES ARE FREE."
